Monday Meetings to Move to Wendy's, 22611 Ventura Blvd., Woodland Hills, on Feb 19th

Ron Ross the proprietor of the Wendy's Restaurant in the Platt Village has not been able to renew his lease. The restaurant will cease business on February 26, 2018 and vacate the building on February 28th. (He was outbid by Starbucks, which desired to have a drive-thru in Platt Village)

Wings Over Wendy's will move their Monday meetings on **February 19th** to the Wendy's Restaurant, 22611 Ventura Blvd, Woodland Hills, CA, just 3 miles from Platt Village. Ron Ross is remodeling the Woodland Hills restaurant in January and is going out of his way to accommodate the Wings Over Wendy's meetings.

The details on the layout of the new meeting room will not be determined until after January 16th, the scheduled completion date of the remodel. We will then inform members of the layout and procedures in the February Wings News. Hold back on suggestions and concerns until after the remodel.

We have scheduled the Wings Over Wendy's biannual picture to be taken at the Platt Village restaurant on **February 12th**, the date of the last meeting.

The first meeting at the Woodland Hills location will be **President's Day, February 19th**. For historical purposes we plan to also take a group picture outside the new location on that date.

Please wear the Wings Over Wendy's hats and shirts on both dates.

The employees of both restaurants are aware of the closure but please be considerate of their situation.

We have assigned tasks to Wings Over Wendy's members to facilitate the move and operation in the new location. Please cooperate with their carrying out those tasks if asked.

On December 4th, Paula Sandling and Lilian Holt from the San Fernando Valley Ninety-Nines presented Wings Over Wendy's with tins of Christmas cookies. The Ninety-Nines, Inc. was founded November 2, 1929, at Curtiss Field in Valley Stream, Long Island, New York. At that time, there were 117 women pilots worldwide. All were invited to attend a meeting in Long Island to discuss the possibility of establishing an organization of women pilots. Only a handful was able to attend the meeting, however, Louise Thaden was elected secretary and worked tirelessly to keep the group together as they struggled to organize and grow. Of the 117 originally invited, 99 joined to become charter members. The group took its name from the number of charter members and in 1931 elected Amelia Earhart its first president. The Ninety-Nines, Inc., is now an international organization of licensed women pilots from 35 countries – and currently have over 6,500 members throughout the world.

Every year the San Fernando Valley Chapter of The Ninety-Nines participates in a "Cookies to the Tower" program where the members distribute Christmas cookies to the Air Traffic Controllers and other personnel in the local area airport towers. They annually stop by Wings Over Wendy's to include us in their distribution. A poem was read to the group upon the presentation of the cookies.



In remembrance of Pearl Harbor members over 80 in attendance were asked by Ed Reynolds to describe their memory of the day. It ranged from the older learning about the attack as they were out and about on a Sunday to some of the younger not hearing about the attack until the next morning when they went to school.

Morris and his wife Nancy worked five, 10-hour days each week they were in country with volunteers from throughout the world ranging in age from 18 to 89. They were provided three kosher meals a day and issued army work uniforms. Their specific task was to refurbish Combat Field Packs that weight 60 pounds. They replaced medicines that had expired and tools that needed repair.

Each Thursday afternoon they would leave the Israeli Defense Forces Teleshamir Matzrap Base, and travel an hour to Tel Aviv where they stayed in a motel. They had to get use to the shutdown from 2pm on Friday to 5pm on Sunday, which limited their ability to move around and visit the city shops and restaurants. Morris and Nancy had toured Israel in the past, so they understood the situation. They saw armed soldiers, both female and male all over the place.




